

Aimee's Proposal Bracelet

Your Proposal Bracelet was handmade for you out of 14 gauge Sterling Silver. It is set with six 6mm cabochon stones and is connected with a 6mm sterling silver bead on wrapped 20 gauge sterling silver wire. It was designed and created for you. Kris ordered this bracelet for you to have as a memory of this time.

The first link is **AIMEE**. It is represented by a Green Swarovski Crystal (for Emerald) to represent May, the month of your birth. Splendid Emerald green is a color communicating harmony, love of nature and a joy of life. It has also been the color of life, beauty and of eternal love.

Song of Solomon 4:1 How beautiful you are, my darling! Oh, how beautiful! (NIV)

Song of Solomon 6:3 I am my beloved's, and my beloved is mine... (KJV)

The second link is **WILL**. This stone is aquamarine. Its name has been derived from the Latin terms "aqua" meaning water, and "mare" or sea. According to ancient traditions, carrying an aquamarine is supposed to guarantee a happy marriage and to make its owner happy.

Song of Solomon 8:7 Many waters cannot quench love; rivers cannot wash it away. ...

The third link is **YOU**. This stone is a Pink Lab-grown Sapphire. The Rose colored stone, historically, is a symbol of love and beauty

Song of Solomon 4:9-10 You have stolen my heart, my sister, my bride; you have stolen my heart with one glance of your eyes,... How delightful is your love, my sister, my bride! ...

The fourth link is **MARRY**. This stone is a Blue Swarovski Crystal to represent blue sapphire. Sapphire blue is a color related to anything permanent and reliable, and this is one of the reasons why women in many countries settle on Sapphire for their engagement rings. Sapphire symbolizes loyalty and faithfulness, while at the same time expressing love and yearning.

Hebrews 13:4 Let Marriage be held in honor among all,...

The fifth link is **ME**. This stone is a Clear Swarovski Crystal representing a Diamond. The name "diamond" comes from the Greek word "adamas" which means unconquerable-suggesting the eternity of love. Since ancient Greece diamonds have been the traditional symbol of love.

Song of Solomon 8:6 Place me like a seal over your heart, like a seal on your arm; for love is as strong as death, its jealousy unyielding as the grave. It burns like blazing fire, like a mighty flame.

The sixth link is **KRIS**. This stone, Red Swarovski Crystal (used for Ruby) represents July, the Month of his birth. The ruby is associated with love and vividness, passion and power and symbolizes love, it emanates warmth and a strong sense of life.

Song of Solomon 5:16 ...This is my beloved and this is my friend,...

Proverbs 17:17 A friend loves at all times...

Use the ET logo link to help you fasten the clasp. Hold the link with your middle finger against the base of your thumb. Bring the bracelet around your hand and fasten to the jump ring closest to the last cross link. Be careful not to twist the bead link from front to back. Repeatedly doing so could cause the link to break. Remember if you have any problems or repairs that I will do so at no charge.
